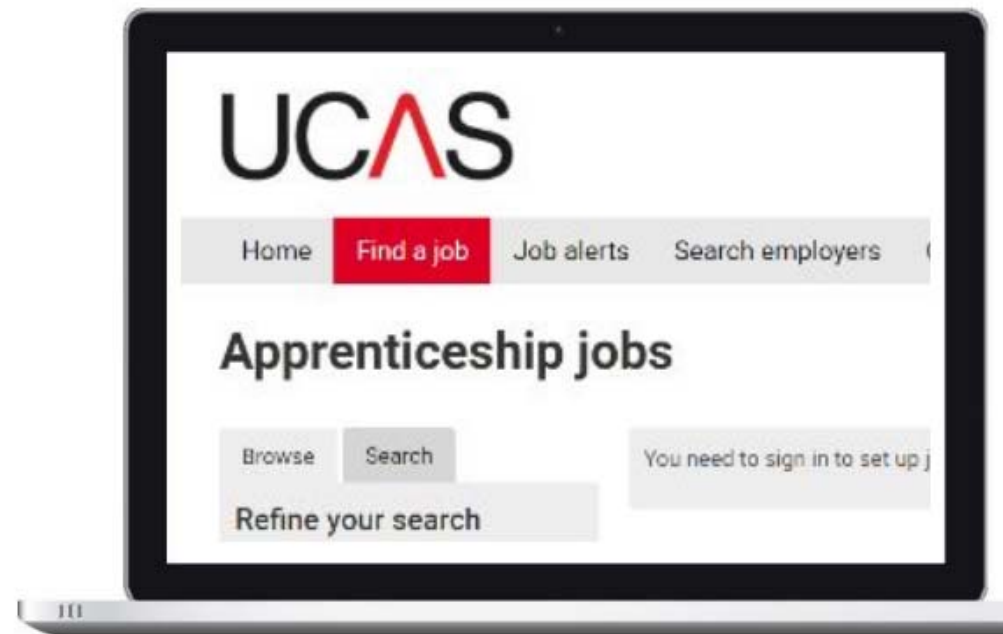

Apprenticeship Type	Value of qualification	Equivalent to academic study	Typical entry Requirements
Degree Apprenticeship	Level 6 & 7	Bachelors degree or Masters degree	A Levels (UCAS points score)
Higher Apprenticeship	Level 4 & 5	Certificate of Higher education or Diploma of Higher Education	A Levels (UCAS points score)
Advanced Apprenticeship	Level 3	2 A Levels or IB	GCSE A - C
Intermediate Apprenticeship	Level 2	5 GCSEs A*-C	GCSE pass at D - G

jobs?

- Within 3 miles of Borehamwood there are 181 Apprenticeship jobs currently on offer
- Within 10 miles there are 288 jobs
- Within 20 miles there are 859 jobs
- Within 50 miles there are 1550 jobs
- The government has confirmed that at least 2.3 per cent of the workforce in public sector bodies in England will have to be apprentices, in a move requiring that 200,000 more will have to be recruited by 2020.
