

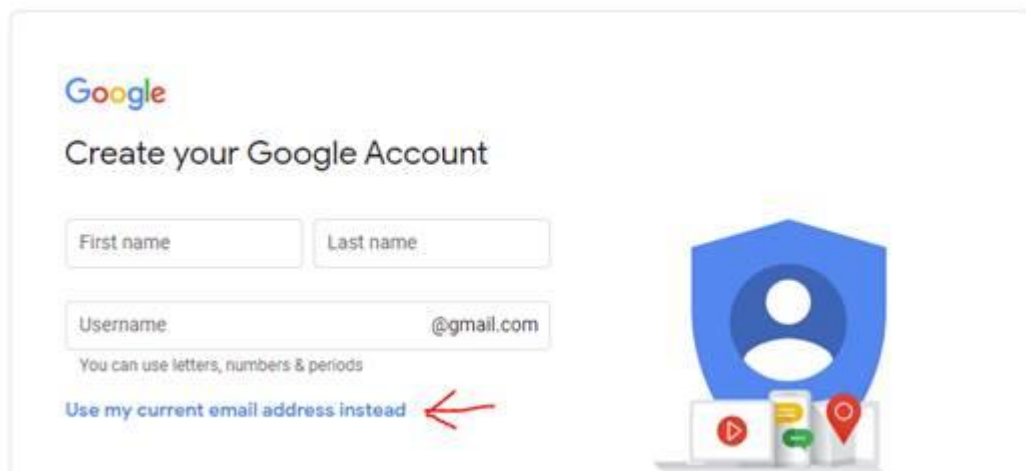
Chromebook Setting Up

Chromebooks require a Google Account to use them.

Using a personal Google account

If you have a personal Gmail account you can use this to sign into the Chromebook. If you don't have a Gmail account but have a personal email address with another email provider e.g. Hotmail, you can create a Google Account with your personal email address via this link selecting the option 'Use my current email address instead':

Using a Yavneh Google account

If you do not have a personal email account nor want to use a personal Google account, you can use your Yavneh email address and network password to setup the Chromebook. As this is a school account, it will be subject to certain limitations – e.g. the Google Play store will only allow you to install apps from an approved list for school use.

Initial Setup

Please follow the initial setup wizard when powering up the Chromebook for the first time:

- Connect to your Wi-Fi network
- Agree to the Google Terms of Service
- When prompted 'Who using this Chromebook' select 'You'
- It will then prompt you to sign into your Chromebook and you can sign in with the Google account you created using the link above or your Yavneh Google account.
